Strategy: Targeted poverty alleviation

Who to Offer Help

- A management network with clearly defined roles for each level of government
- Performance evaluation and incentives for poverty alleviation officials
- Establishing resident working teams with capable & experienced officials responsible for each poor village and household

How to Help

Five-pronged measures:

- Boosting the economy to create jobs
- Relocating the poor from inhospitable areas
- Eco-compensation
- Improving education
- Providing subsistence allowances

When & How to De-register

- Following clear standards & procedures for deregistering from the poor list
- Public review, government examination & third-party evaluation for de-registration
- A nationwide survey to assess the real effects of poverty alleviation (2020-early 2021)

How to Prevent Relapse

For counties, preferential policies will remain in place for five years after deregistration

For households, regular
 checkups, dynamic monitoring
 and continuous support will
 follow
